



ACCEPTABLE DEVICE REQUIREMENTS

St. Dominic Savio Catholic High School is a BYOD (bring your own device) school. As such, each student is required to have an acceptable mobile device (as defined below) to be used in the classroom as required by the instructor.

Device requirements *

1. **Operating System: Must be 64 bit version of Windows 7 or higher or Apple device with OS X 10.10 or later.**

*** NOTE: iPad (iOS) products and Chromebooks are NOT acceptable devices due to programs that are required in core courses that are not compatible with these devices.**

2. Minimum i5 processor, 128GB hard drive, 8 GB RAM
3. Must be able to access the internet via Wifi that supports 802.11n connectivity
4. Must have active, up to date antivirus software installed (see the Acceptable Antivirus Software list below)
5. Must install Microsoft Office 365 via a FREE download from the [Savio website](#) in order to facilitate collaboration with teachers and students within the Office products
6. Must have latest version of Java installed
7. Must be able to read, edit and create with Google Apps and store on Google Drive
8. Sufficient battery capacity to last the school day

* PLTW has their own specifications for devices running the PLTW software that will be utilized in the Engineering and Computer Science courses. The school will provide devices that meet these specifications for use during a student's Engineering or Computer Science class time. Notes

1. Students will be assigned a Gmail email address within the Savio domain (@student.saviochs.org) required for access to school licensed, web-based resources such as Microsoft Office 365 and Google Apps for Education. These products facilitate collaboration and assignment submission.
2. Students will be required to enroll their acceptable device with our Mobile Device Management (MDM) system in order to access the wireless network.
3. Student devices may be required to have Savio classroom management software installed on them.
4. Make sure you select a device that your student is comfortable operating and typing on in class. Some classes may require digital textbooks and the reading of such should be taken into account when choosing a device.

POLICY REMINDER: Use of 3G or 4G mobile hotspots, tethering to/from a device, or using VPN or other services to bypass the School's security and filtering measures or for any other non-school approved purpose, is prohibited. **Access to the internet will be permitted through the Savio wireless network ONLY.**
