Principal's Update: Mr. Morgan Daniels

- 102 Seniors!
- Thank you SPA for the treats/cupcakes for the 383 students that started yesterday.
- Also, thank you for the first water station which was installed during the summer; will be installing second water station upstairs.
- This week starting transition from having "Families" to a "House System". Students choosing 2 representatives from each House. House system busy getting started on homecoming. New system, get feedback from students faculty; see how it works for Savio. Details in Eagle Weekly.
- Collecting lots of forms this week; new form parking pass system; knowing who is in our parking lot to protect our students; faculty has parking pass, no more auction spots on campus.
- Freshman retreat orientation went really well; kids had a good time; t-shirts late in coming.
- Back to school night in two weeks, 6:30pm, short presentations; script from SPA, send off to the classes. SPA welcoming people; lot of people needed for the future years.
- Senior college boot camp went well, lot of reps from admissions offices; the Naviance is having some hiccups, plan in place to repair. As long as the students are doing their part, go in see counselor, get all your stuff in. College rep visits will start soon.

President's Update: Dr. Joan Wagner

- We've had a busy summer, introduced new employee manual coming from diocese across the board of schools.
- Two schools with growing budgets, tuition assistance to be awarded, about 20% for Savio, \$530,000 grew from \$200,000 a few years ago. A lot of challenges with kids in high school, we are here to support those in need. Happy to be able to help, makes a wonderful community.
- Traffic changes with opening of Neenah; next step to expand Neenah, widen the lanes; give us feedback through the office if experiencing problems exiting or entering. Holy Family has crossing guard, quite costly, which helps Savio as well, pauses traffic and keeps system going; as soon as the road opens, will go to flashing lights with crosswalk; reduce speed from 30 to 20. Police officers are monitoring the speed; announcement will be made to students to follow speed limit.
- Building wise going good; capital campaign at Holy Family, growth out here is huge; we are serving 7 parishes.
- We have annual goal with strategic plan; will be in Eagle Weekly when finalized. Main categories, things that are important and get addressed during the school year, 6-7 goals per year, continuing process.

 Julie – problem with light being short at Parmer; who do we call to report? Marguerite - turning left out of Holy Family to go to Savio is delayed. Will review & discuss with both principals and see what can be done.
