The school, located in northwest Austin, provides instructional methods with a 21st century classroom experience that incorporates cooperative learning and problem-solving approaches, along with technology integrations to enhance learning. St. Dominic Savio offers a variety of extensive academic courses that meet diverse student interests. Accelerated students may qualify for Pre-AP and AP courses in the subject areas of

art, computer science, English, foreign languages, mathematics, natural science, and social science.

As students advance through their academic career, they can choose to concentrate on different areas of study, either in the STEM field (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics), Fine Arts, or the Humanities. All graduates receive Distingushed Diplomas, with at least one of the four endorsements: Multidisciplinary Studies, Arts and Humanities, STEM, or Business and Industry. Four years of engineering and computer science programs are offered through the Project Lead the Way curriculum, the leading STEM program in the United States. These experiences provide a foundation for college preparation and career readiness.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

St. Dominic Savio offers 39 Pre-AP and AP level courses. These options provide great flexibility in meeting the needs and interests of each student. Students have scored above state and national averages on the PSAT, SAT and ACT exams. In 2016-2017, 154 students completed 373 AP exams in 21 subjects, with 78% scoring a 3 or higher. In addition, we had:

- 15 AP Scholars with Honor
- 25 AP Scholars with Distinction
- 8 National AP Scholars

Since the first graduating class in 2012, additional academic accomplishments include:

The Class of 2017 are attending over 50 universities and colleges and 1% are following a vocation to the religious life. Savio graduates have received acceptances from more than 180 colleges and universities since 2012.
