Both athletic and general parent survey provided good feedback. Athletic facilities Master Plan (MP) has been in the Strategic Plan for 2nd year. Debt on school keeps the Athletic MP from being implemented; launching a Diocesan-approved capital campaign is complicated weaving it in to all the Diocesan and parish campaigns. Existing athletic program operations were discussed, indicating a strong need for more streamlined operations with most sports. Permit was approved for Holy Family. Holy Family is launching a website.

Open House was successful. For next year, promotions will be enhanced for bringing in more prospective families. The 7 minute school video produced by Catholic House is completed; it provides an overview of the school and its programs. A large grant for tuition was submitted to the Kenedy Foundation. A "giving" ad was published in the Austin Business Journal. The Savio website home page revision update will be completed the beginning of December. Most parishes have completed their promotional weekends, There are three left. Encouraged attendees to follow Savio on social media, which Dr. Garcia is using extensively.
