Principal's Update: Dr. Enrique Garcia

Not Present

President's Update: Dr. Joan Wagner

Current strategic plan is complete and was posted in June 2019. A copy of the plan was provided to faculty and school board for input. Parent survey will be sent out shortly. Plan should be up for approval early this fall. The strategic plan includes statement about bullying. Bullying is not a specific concern, but questions came up through accreditation process, and administration wanted to address it.

Currently developing athletic master plan. Plans ensure everything is properly permitted (including working around the heritage trees located on property). Considering needs of all sports. Talking with coaches about facilities needed for each sport. Have determined that a full football field and 8-lane track will fit within boundaries of available property. At this point, the master plan design represents the grand idea. Will need to fundraise, and work on realizing plan in stages. The largest expenses are football field and track. Plan includes parking.

Recently had groundbreaking for Holy Family construction project. The school is 20 years old and is in need of additional space. Construction includes the addition of interior building space, and an open-air pavilion for performances (this space can be used by Savio). At this time, neither Holy Family nor Savio will have dedicated cafeteria space.

Communications: Ms. Cristina Mares:

Reaching out to alumni through 10th anniversary celebration. Seniors lose Savio email address upon graduation, so Cristina asks them for contact information prior to leaving school. Working on sending out Savio Now – hitting mail boxes this coming week. Currently, marketing Savio to local parishes. All are welcome to alumni events.

<u>Principal's Update:</u> Dr. Enrique Garcia

- Vocations Week activities going on all week (11/4 11/8). Inviting students to consider their vocation religious or not.
- Friendsgiving House Council is discussing how to improve event organization and communication. Currently, they are preparing for Friendsgiving (11/21) Those bringing a warm dish must bring it in a crockpot with a disposable liner for easier cleanup. Working with Mr. Pendergrass to make sure power strips are available. Council representatives to meet with Lori Dewan to work out plan SPA volunteers can be available to accept food; arrange buffet service when ready to eat; and manage clean-up. SPA will also provide paper goods & plastic. The House Council is looking to efficiently organize Friendsgiving and International Day with a full meal potluck but may have to consider alternatives. Will debrief after this month's Friendsgiving event and decide how to move forward with future events.

Approval of the Minutes: November 5, 2019 - Approved

<u>**Principal's Update:**</u> Dr. Enrique Garcia:

- Friendsgiving: Dr. Garcia reported that Friendsgiving went smoothly, but he plans to get more feedback through a debrief session with participants. Scheduling TBD.
- Thursday's (12/5) Principal's Coffee is with House Council. Dr. Garcia encourages parents to go to learn more about house system.
- Fall play production went well, and on Thursday (12/5) student will present a Christmas play.
- Athletics is focused on winter sports.
- In response to parent feedback, homework was not assigned during Thanksgiving break. In addition, there will be no homework assignments during Christmas break.
- Invite will go out to SPA representative for annual scheduling meeting in April aim to reduce scheduling conflicts with SPA sponsored events.
- Savio Coaches Discussion: Dr. Garcia asks if coaches should attend the holiday lunch and receive a cash gift. He is looking for opportunities include coaches in the greater Savio community. Some parents and teachers don't interact much with coaching staff because coaches volunteer. They don't work at Savio. If teachers and coaches knew each other, they could potentially work together to help students when needed. It was decided that this issue needed more discussion. Sarah will talk with Booster Club about financially supporting the addition of coaches to teacher lunches. Dr. Garcia is interested in inviting coaches to teacher lunches at the beginning of the school year, Christmas, and at the end of the year.

President's Update: Dr. Joan Wagner:

- Update on Athletic Master Plan: The Board found that a full football field and 8-lane track can fit in the proposed space. The total plan is estimated to cost \$12 million so the project will need to be completed in stages. A baseball and softball field will be developed in phase 1, and plans are currently being finalized. Donations are in place to cover cost of phase 1. Savio cannot take on more debt so additional donor and Booster Club funds will be needed to pay for ongoing work.
- Evaluating use of 8 acres south of Neenah. Board members to begin brainstorming needs and possible uses. A meeting is scheduled for January.
- The aim is to create a long-term vision about developing available space. Long-term enrollment goals are around 600, but nearer-term development phases involve expanding the current school building. There is also space where portables & busses are located, and Board is evaluating how to best use this area.
- Budget: A first draft of next year's budget was presented to Board in the November meeting.

• Encourages all families to participate in school survey. Administration wants to know what is important to school families.

Communications: Cristina Mares

- Advancing-the-Mission-Grants were submitted yesterday.
- Grants for tuition assistance and engineering are out and responses are expected after the first of the year.
- Focus on getting out announcements and sharing information about Savio. *Savio Now* is a 10th Anniversary piece expect out during the week of 12/2.
- Continuing with admissions; ramping up for Catholic Schools weeks; and promoting Savio in parishes.
- Dr. Garcia asked if SPA has reached out to families of students transferring into Savio in January 2020. Sarah and Lori Dewan will talk with Mrs. Bologna specifically to invite new parents to January Principal's Coffee.

Principal's Update: Dr. Enrique Garcia

- Thanked everyone for help during Catholic Schools Week (CSW). Soup lunch expanded to include sandwiches and brownies! Successful CSW: Imago Christi Day went smoothly. Student participated in a variety of activities. Savio Film Works (students) made a video of CSW activities, and it is posted on social media.
- Ramping up for second semester. Sent out event dates for next school year to give families advanced notice on key dates.
