Approval of the Minutes: May 5, 2020 - Approved

Principal's Update: Dr. Enrique GarciaIntroductions of 2020-21 SPA Board

- There are several new hires: Three new Theology Teachers including a new Dominican Sister; a Geometry teacher (Ms. Busker); PE teacher; Director of Development and Director of Communication. Looking to hire a new Director of Formation and Ministry. Savio's Chinese teacher will teach online until a replacement is found.
- There are also several new coaches. Football and volleyball have both started practice. Anticipates sports will go on, but unclear if there can be spectators.
- Classes all online this week. Savio has purchased equipment that helps make online teacher easier including new speaker phones. Some students will be physically going to class starting next week.
- Discussed how many students are planning to attend in person classes. Mr. Goertz and Mrs. Schiesser are
 working on final numbers because many families have changed their minds over the past few weeks. Dr. Garcia
 will send out numbers. Classroom limit is 15 students.

Communications: Katherine Mackowski:

- No specific updates.
- Discussion about developing more detailed social media communication plan to promote Savio. Young people are using Instagram Savio should use Instagram to reach out to kids.
- New parent owns a sign business and has offered help. Dr. Garcia has spoken with her to see how we could use signs.

Development: Gina Kerley:

- Build the Nest will continue this year using same structure with class captains, but gatherings will be virtual. Working on ways to do these gatherings creatively.
- Grandparents Day Plan to offer virtual mass. Scheduled for week prior to Thanksgiving
- Soiree will not be in November. Tentatively set date for April 10th hope to hold it in person. Gina plans to start involving parent volunteers this fall to work on Soiree.

Jessica suggests that Class Reps should get together to discuss how to handle class breakfasts.



Approval of the Minutes: September 1, 2020: Approved

<u>Principal's Update:</u> Dr. Enrique Garcia

- Introducing new Spiritual Director Gian Gamboa to students and staff. See bio in Eagle Weekly.
- Started Phase II Opening more students are attending school in person. Football, Volleyball and Cross Country are practicing/playing games. Winter sports are starting off-season practice (Basketball, Soccer, and Swimming).
- Next principal's coffee is coming up. Topics TBD.
- Next week is a "goofy" week. No school on Monday and Friday. PSAT for Juniors will be held on Wednesday. SAT is optional for Seniors.
- Faculty and Staff retreat Bishop Bill Wack spoke.
- Scheduled to start self-assessment for Accreditation, but Ms. Poe has agreed to push back 2 years. Starting the accreditation process at this time was too much to manage with Covid.
- In process of hiring new Government instructor. Mr. Jameson will stay through current semester.
- Phase II going smoothly thus far. The Freshman class has the most students attending in person; followed by the Sophomore class, Seniors and finally Juniors. Also installing desk shields and more hand sanitizer dispensers. Dr. Garcia feels confident about the protocols the school has put in place.

<u>President's Update:</u> Dr. Joan Wagner

- Strategic Plan: A draft is complete, and it should be approved at the end of October. The plan will be distributed after it is approved.
- Construction continues, and HF should receive Certificate of Occupancy in November.
- Refinancing loan for Savio and HF reduces interest expense, allowing for some more budget flexibility.
- Currently developing new 5-year financial plan that will consider teachers (salaries) and investment in facilities. The first draft of the five-year plan should be complete in December. The plan would start in September 2021.
- Athletic facilities plan: Dr. Wagner is considering having a model created to show facilities. Fundraising is key.
 Dr. Wagner wants to communicate vision and jump start funding for this is a long-term project. Fundraising will happen through donations and/or bringing down debt to a level where it is possible to responsibly borrow more.



Approval of the Minutes: October 6, 2020

<u>Principal's Update:</u> Dr. Enrique Garcia:

- Introduced Mr. Gian Gamboa, Savio's new Director of Formation & Ministry
- Homecoming activities took place last week, and it went well. Homecoming game was on October 30th against
 the Christian Lions. 500 tickets were sold to Savio students, families and staff, and another 100 to the opposing
 team.
- Tim Team is arranging speakers for Vocation Week. Single and married life speakers will be featured.
- Student lead conferences will be held this week (November 6th). Teachers will get "survival kits" from SPA on Thursday.
- Fall sports is wrapping up. Volleyball will have playoffs this week. Winter Sports are ramping up Softball, Swim, Soccer, and Basketball. Spring sports to start off-season training.
- More students are using the network that's shared with Holy Family, and it's causing bandwidth issues. Mr. Molinar is working on assessing issues and options. Looking at more permanent solution so system will be more flexible as needs fluctuate.
- Mr. Goertz is organizing final exams. They will not follow the regular format. Mr. Goertz will roll out in the coming weeks.

Development: Gina Kerley:

Approval of the Minutes: November 3, 2020: Approved

<u>Principal's Update:</u> Dr. Enrique Garcia

- Friendsgiving went well want to offer more games for kids so they can hang out outside. DJ Bolin is an Eagle Scout. He is working on project to build benches for outdoor areas on Savio campus.
- Plan to continue offering in-person mass but will continue to assess as Covid conditions change.
- Two weeks left in first semester. Non-traditional finals to follow. Students were assigned a smaller project in lieu of finals.
- Dr. Wagner announced her retirement.
- Replacement for Chris Jameson has been hired, and he will be a full-time coach.

President's Update: Dr. Joan Wagner

- Plans to retire in June, but there is a lot to do!
- Strategic plan was approved in November and posted on Eagle Weekly. Completed bond refinancing, and this
 gives more clarity to Savio's financial situation. Will use this information to develop more complete 5-year plan.
 Sensitive to rising cost of tuition and teacher salaries. Will be presenting budget for approval in December (the
 first year in current five-year plan). Includes items normally in budget transportation (new buses), salaries,
 etc...
- Savio's bond financing is structured with a 15-year term. Savio will need to pay down this debt before it can take
 on a costly capital project (like a sports facility) unless significant project specific money is raised independently
 through a fundraising campaign.
- The biggest financial outlay in future plans is athletic facilities (baseball, softball area).
- Please participate in parent survey so administration can better assess parent priorities.
- Construction at Holy Family is moving along. Three buildings should be completed in January. The pavilion includes restrooms, elevated stage (ability for microphones and sound) and set-up to serve food. It will be available to Savio.
