<u>Principal's Update:</u> Mr. Psencik congratulated the students who decided to participate in his challenge to donate to the Eagle Fund. Students who donated anywhere from \$5, \$10, to \$20 received a dress down pass for their donation. 50% of the student body donated! Mr. P also encouraged faculty and staff to donate to the Eagle Fund, offering to match each donation. As of today, 70% of faculty/staff has donated. Most participation ever!

Advancement: Gina Kerley "survived" week of Giving in both schools.
