**Faculty Updates**

- **Principal:** Upcoming presentations 10/07 in AM/PM from SMART Family on understanding technology effects on teenage brain-students will also get presentation; 10/08 is fall concert (band/orchestra); next week is the end of the quarter with report cards coming out the following week; paper towels were removed from the bathrooms due to vandalism and costly plumbing

repairs; faculty are aware of issue with power of hand dryers and are working on it; many other upcoming school events - see Eagle Update for details

- **President:** Will likely need to move location of information session on 10/17 due to the PSAT-new location has not yet been chosen; lighting project work and fundraising for this project ongoing; working on procuring 12 person van for school use-diocese will not approve the 15 person van that was originally chosen-encourages placing students above faculty with any fund limitations that arise
- **Admissions:** Upcoming 10/16 prospective parent information session - need some current parent volunteers for Q&A before and after session; open house in November
- **Advancement:** Sept 29-Oct 3 was the Savio week of giving, working on increasing parent and student participation in giving, goal 100% participation, currently at ~25% \$150k and goal is 250k-plan on offering house points to the winning house for student participation next year; casino night is 11/15 - more details to come; the Savio soiree is 4/18 at Hyatt Regency Downtown - planning an information session to inform on purpose of soiree; grandparents day is 11/19 (invitations going out next week)
- **Communications:** The school is recording the fall concert on 10/08; an ad has been placed on Facebook for SDS admissions - please share with your friends/community if you see it; there is an upcoming book fair fundraiser from 10:30-13:30 at Barnes and Noble on 183N. - **Treasurer** - added two senior breakfasts into the budget, increased the soiree sponsored angel tickets
- **Secretary** - no updates, will send out reminder for Eagle Updates the Monday prior to EU.

- **Freshman rep:** Upcoming freshman breakfast on 10/17 - date may change, consider consolidating parent class chat groups

- **Sophomore rep:** Sophomore breakfast on 09/17 went very well with correct amount of food, preorder at Krispy Kreme has cost savings over Round Rock donuts, Shipley's may also be priced well, the soap is now working in the boy's bathroom
- **Junior rep:** Junior breakfast on 10/03 went very well, people getting used to concession stand, using white boards to remind students of event was helpful
- **Senior rep:** Upcoming senior class retreat on 10/15-10/16 - ongoing preparations for that event but everything is organized. We will send out the sign-up link for volunteers soon.
