St. Dominic Savio offers a caring and supportive family environment for students of all backgrounds to come together as community to learn, grow, and play. Engagement within the St. Dominic Savio community is an essential component of fulfilling our mission of preparing young men and women to become faith-filled, visionary, and inspirational leaders in service to the Church and the world.

St. Dominic Savio's student-led House System builds community among students across grade levels fostering a sense of belonging, identity, cooperation, and mutual respect. Each House is comprised of four smaller groups, or "families" creating a more intimate community setting. New students are randomly placed within a family. The four Houses engage in friendly competition throughout the school year earning "house points" with the end of year goal of winning the prized Evangelist Cup. As a student lead system it provides a forum to develop qualities of servant leadership "in the image of Christ". St. Dominic Savio faculty and staff serve as mentors for each family providing an additional means for them to engage holistic formation of students - spiritual, intellectual, social, and emotional. Students meet with their families each week providing a fun, consistent, and varied social experience.

Beyond the Classroom

Students are motivated to learn inside and outside the classroom. St. Dominic Savio has something for everyone to engage their interests, stay active, get involved, and feel part of our thriving community. We offer a variety of clubs, competitive groups, and honor societies to join or you can start your own. A comprehensive Fine Arts program is available to students with opportunities in both visual and performing arts. Savio students can also compete on our varsity and sub-varsity athletic teams. In most years, nearly eighty-five percent of the students at St. Dominic Savio participate in athletics. Savio athletes have had several district and regional championships in multiple sports including 7 State Championships for softball, girl's track and field, boy's and girl's swimming and girl's cross country. Off the athletic field Savio has had four state championships awarded in music and TAPPS Academic State Championships in 2017, 2018 and 2023. Equally successful is our Iron Eagles Robotics team earning the title of the 2023 TAPPS State Champion, qualifying for several World Championships and twice ranked internationally. At St. Dominic Savio we believe that involvement in these extra-curricular activities develops the whole person instilling collaboration and servant leadership, understanding their responsibility to give back to the community around them making a difference in the world.
